

MARSHALL FIELD PLAYGROUND, Vernon, BC

The Marshall Field Playground was created under the Jumpstart program, which is supported by a Canadian Tire. Erik Mustonen was project manager and landscape designer for the City of Vernon on a fast-track schedule, coordinating between Jumpstart with its suppliers and contractors, City of Vernon Operations Services (Public Works and Parks Services), engineering consultants and external contractors. The project involved topographic survey, geotechnical engineering, site planning, grading, subsurface drainage, base preparation, play equipment installation and testing, safety surface installation, concrete paving, site furniture installation, planting, and upgrades to nearby washrooms. Jumpstart normally allows two years for similar projects, but this one was completed in one year.
